### **Updated Press Release – NPD Seeks Assistance from Public Reported Assault-Stabbing September 13, 2017**

The Northfield Police Department continues to investigate the stabbing that took place at a residence on Kennedy Court. The victim has been released from the hospital and is expected to recover.

NPD Investigators are requesting help from the public. Investigators would like to speak to a man who picked up a female in the downtown area and dropped her off on Kennedy Court, on Friday, September 8, 2017 between 10:45 a.m. and 11:30 p.m. If you are the person who provided the ride, or if you saw this take place, please contact police.

Investigators would also like to speak with anyone who observed suspicious activity in the Kennedy Court area, between 10:30 a.m. and 11:45 a.m. on the same date.

Please call the non-emergency number 507-645-4477, and ask to speak with an officer if you have information related to the incident as described above.

#### **Previous Press Release Information:**

On September 8, 2017 at about 12:15 p.m., Northfield Officers and Northfield Hospital EMS responded to the 1800 block of Kennedy Court for a person who reported being stabbed, at a residence there.

At the scene, Officers discovered an adult female (approximately 40 years of age) who had suffered at least one serious stab wound. She was treated at the scene and the Northfield Hospital before being flown to HCMC for surgery. Her condition is not known at this time.

There is no specific suspect description, or additional incident information currently available. Police are not aware of any danger to the public.

This investigation is open and active with numerous Officers and Investigators involved. No other information is likely to be available for several days.
